# GARDALL® DRIVE-SEAL

### DESCRIPTION

- An ultra-premium grade acrylic based clear coating suitable for use on driveways.

### BENEFITS

- Quick drying to provide a hard wearing finish.
- UV resistant, non-yellowing.
- Very good hot tyre resistance.
- Resists growth of moss and algae.
- Water-based – easy clean up and lower odour.

### RECOMMENDED USE

- Recommended for applications where a hard and/or fast drying water-based coating is required.
- Suitable for use on concrete, clay pavers and reconstituted limestone.
- Topcoat sealer for spray-on paving.
- **Not recommended for use on timber decking.**

### BASIC DATA

- **APPLICATION:** Brush and spray (roller not recommended)
- **COVERAGE RATE:** Approximately 10 square metres per litre – will vary depending on substrate
- **GLOSS LEVEL:** Available in Matt
- **THINNER:** Not generally required - up to 10% with water
- **CLEAN UP:** Water – brushes and spray equipment must be cleaned immediately with water before the product has a chance to dry. Clean brushes between coats.
- **RE-COAT:** 20-30 minutes (depending on conditions) – drying time will be longer in cool/humid conditions

### SURFACE PREPARATION

- Surfaces must be clean, dry, and free of dust, grease, oils and wax.
  - A quick check for moisture would be to tape down a small sheet of plastic film onto the substrate – after 1 hour, check for condensation on the underside. If condensation is present, the substrate is too damp to paint.
- **DO NOT APPLY IF TEMPERATURE IS LESS THAN 10°C OR GREATER THAN 35°C.**

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Stir to a consistent viscosity before application.
- Apply 2 coats of Gardall® Drive-Seal for best results.

## SAFETY

- Provide adequate ventilation during use.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- Do not pour left over sealer down any drains.
- **FIRST AID:** If swallowed, give plenty of water to drink and seek medical attention.  
If in eyes, rinse with lots of water for at least 15 minutes – seek medical assistance.  
If skin contact occurs, wash with warm soapy water – contact a doctor of irritation persists.
